



POLICE CHIEF

The Rural Municipality of Corman Park, located around the City of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan with a population of approximately 8400, is searching for a Police Chief. The Police Chief reports to the Corman Park Board of Police Commissioners, and oversees all policing activities related to the enforcement of laws as dictated by local, provincial and federal legislation. The position of Police Chief has oversight responsibilities as well as participating in active patrol and investigation. Other responsibilities include:

- Overseeing all general police activities
- Providing leadership to and working with a team of four officers and one part time civilian staff
- Developing short and long term goals, and monitoring activities against progress
- Developing and administering operating budgets and controlling expenditures
- Building, implementing, and managing reactive and pro-active policing plans and programs as required

The incumbent should possess a minimum seven to ten years policing experience, with a minimum of five years experience in a progressively responsible command position. He/she will have superior leadership abilities; excellent verbal and written communication skills; good computer skills; be able to work with the public; and be able to perform general management functions.

Candidates should be a graduate of a police training program recognized by the Saskatchewan Police Commission and have post-secondary education in Police Administration or a combination of equivalent experience and education.
