Kamloops or Cranbrook, B.C.

As a Liquor Inspector, your primary role will be to inspect licensed establishments to ensure public safety through compliance with relevant legislation. Your responsibilities will include, among other things:

- assuring the development of security plans
- liaising with licensees, local government and police
- gathering and presenting evidence for use in administrative hearings
- leading a team of other inspectors in enforcement and compliance activities when required.

You'll also apply your mediation and negotiation skills as you work to resolve social issues between stakeholders in licensed establishments and neighbouring residents or businesses.

You possess the skills necessary to effectively defuse volatile situations through the use of tact, persuasiveness and diplomacy. Regular weekend and night work is the norm here, so if you thrive in a role that doesn't revolve around the usual nine-to-five workday, this could be just what you're looking for.

Surrounded by the hills and river valleys of B.C.'s Southern Interior region, Kamloops (population: 87,000) is the province's third-largest city and features an affordable housing market, its own university, ample parklands and numerous schools and sporting complexes.
