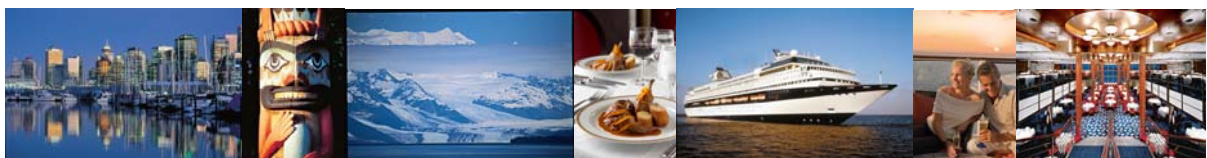

Given the scope of organizing such an event, it has been critical for the organizing committee to secure space with the cruise line prior to it being available for purchase by the general public. The ships and itineraries have not yet been deployed for 2012 so there is the possibility of some changes to ship and itinerary - these details will not be confirmed until the 2012 schedule is announced in April 2011. In the meantime, Celebrity Cruises has offered guaranteed pricing that will not increase and will be closely monitored to ensure we have competitive pricing once the 2012 schedules are released.

In order to take advantage of amenities (extra benefits) that the cruise line has offered our group, it is crucial to secure all interested bookings in a timely manner through the AGM registration process. **Note: Any bookings made through other sources will not qualify for any amenities extended to the group.**

Our group has contracted 310 staterooms in 4 categories. The pricing is in Canadian dollars and listed per person for the 1st and 2nd passenger in each room. Please be aware that the cruise line may restrict the number of rooms we can add to our current contract at the guaranteed price - to avoid disappointment we encourage you to book early.

Category Descriptions:

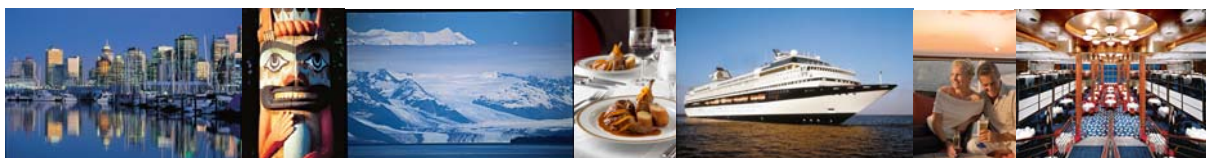
All Staterooms include two lower beds convertible to queen, complimentary 24-hour room service, dual voltage 110/220 AC, complimentary use of bathrobes, bathroom accessories & hair dryer, complimentary beach towel service, safe, direct dial telephone, thermostat controlled air conditioning & mini bar (fees apply).

Inside Staterooms (Cat 10 and 11) – 174 sq ft.

Ocean view Staterooms (Cat 07) – 175 sq ft. Window.

Veranda (Balcony) Staterooms (Cat 2A) – 172 sq ft plus 42 sq ft veranda

Concierge Class Veranda (Cat C2) Stateroom – same as 2A above with the addition of the following amenities/services.

Concierge Class benefits:

Early embarkation and debarkation, priority check-in, welcome sparkling wine, fresh fruit and flowers, specialty restaurant seating preferences, expanded room service breakfast menu, evening hor d'ouvres daily, pillow menu, plush bathrobes, massaging shower head, over-sized towels, tote bag and complimentary shoeshine service, use of golf umbrella, & high-quality binoculars.

Please note: *“Suite” categories are available on a request basis. If you note you would like a suite on your registration form you will be contacted with options and availability.*

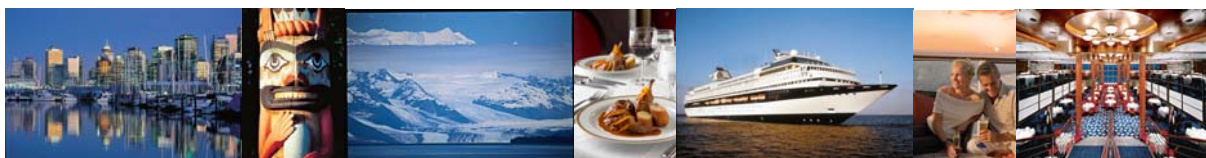

If a passenger is interested in a category of stateroom that is not currently offered in our group, the committee has the ability to request pricing and add the booking to the AGM group. There are also a limited number of staterooms that are wheel chair accessible. These will be assigned on a first come first serve basis.

Taxes & Gratuities:

Taxes are currently priced at \$181 Cdn per person and are subject to change. In order to accommodate our group dining requirements, gratuities must be pre-paid and will be added on to the cruise fare. Cost of gratuities varies by stateroom category.

Fuel Surcharge: Celebrity Cruises reserves the right to impose a fuel supplement on all guests if the price of West Texas Intermediate fuel exceeds \$65 per barrel. 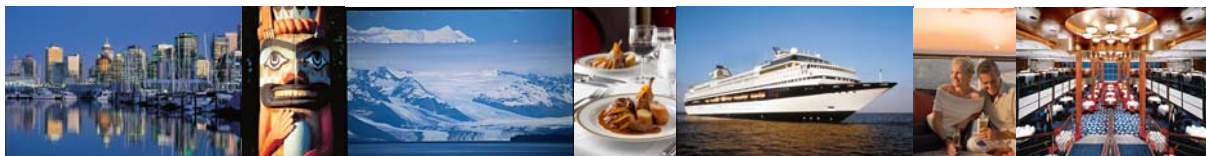

Cancellation Policy:

Any registrations cancelled prior to October 15, 2011 are subject to a \$50 per person fee. Registrations cancelled after October 15, 2011 are non-refundable. Please ensure you have appropriate travel insurance.

Groups/Reunions:

Attendees who utilize this unique AGM venue to organize group reunions – troop, family, etc - are reminded to state so in the space provided on the registration form by assigning your group a “name” (example “Rhonda Thibault’s troop reunion”) and are encouraged to have all members of your group register at the same time. The committee will do their best to ensure staterooms and any meeting space requirements are accommodated.

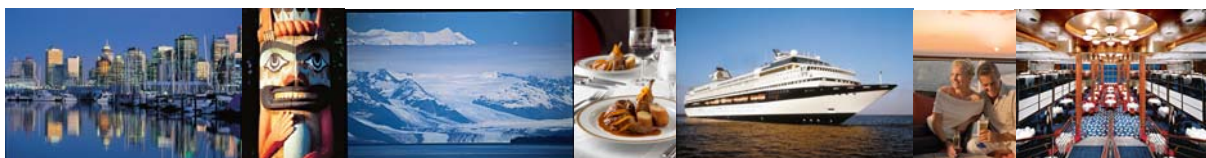
Note: Any “reunion” groups can be registered together in the earliest registration date for any one of their members. For example, if a “troop reunion” consists of members that have different registration dates, all members can register along with the member who has the earliest available date.

Additional Travel Requirements:

With the AGM being a national event there may be additional travel arrangements required by attendees. There is a place on the registration form to indicate if you require additional arrangements such as air, pre and/or post hotel accommodations, parking, transfers, etc. The committee is currently negotiating sponsorships and discounts with airlines, hotels, etc and will have this information available in the spring of 2011. If you indicate the services you require on the registration form, you will be contacted once the information is available.

All registrations received prior to September 30, 2010 will be eligible for 'Early bird' prize draw – WIN A FREE CRUISE for 2!

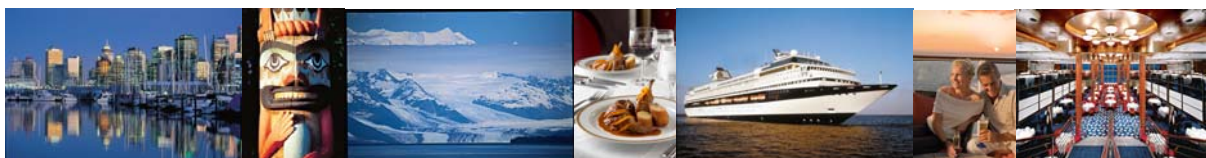

Registration Step by Step procedures:

1. Read all cruise information provided and determine the type of stateroom you would like to book. If you require a 3rd or 4th guest in the same room or a category of room not listed, please continue with the registration process and a CruiseShipCenters representative will contact you to confirm.

3. Once your form is completed, print a copy for yourself (or 2 copies if you are mailing).
